



COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

"Discovery of the Year of the Safe Place Community in the category of Safety Leader" as part of the VII International Scientific and Technical Congress SAFE PLACE 2024

§ 1. General provisions

1. These rules (hereinafter referred to as Competition Rules and Regulations) define the terms and conditions of the Competition 'Discovery of the Year of the Safe Place Community in the Safety Leader category'
2. The organiser of the Competition is Safety Project Sp. z o. o. with its registered office in Wrocław (51-116) at ul. Zaulek Rogoziński 11B/4, registered in the National Court Register - Register of Entrepreneurs by the District Court for Wrocław VI Economic Division of the National Court Register under KRS number 0000936005, tax identification number NIP 8952236010.
3. The Competition is held as part of the VII International Scientific and Technical Congress SAFE PLACE 2024 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Congress')
4. The purpose of the competition is to recognise an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the security industry by demonstrating exceptional leadership, innovation and commitment to raising security standards.
5. Entering the Competition implies acceptance of the Rules.

§ 2. Conditions of Participation

6. Any person attending the Congress can be a participant in the competition (hereinafter: 'Participant')
7. Each person participating in the Congress may nominate three candidates from among the other Congress participants, with the exception of himself/herself.
8. Nominations should be submitted via e-mail, enclosing a statement from the nominated person in which he/she agrees to the sharing of his/her data.
9. The submission should include:
 - Name and surname of nominee,
 - A short biography of the nominee,
 - A photograph of the nominee,
 - The candidate's three most important contributions to improving safety,
 - Written statement of consent to share the candidate's image, signed by candidate.
10. Candidate applications will be accepted between 9 September 2024 and 1- November 2024, at the following e-mail address: kongres@safepolade.edu.pl
11. The nominators may receive a prize of PLN 200.

§ 3. Conduct of the competition

12. All entries will be reviewed by the Competition Jury, consisting of industry experts, including Dr. Natalia Moch and representatives of the organiser.
13. The Candidates will be listed in a printed catalogue and presented during the Congress

14. Based on the applications and presented information, Congress participants will cast their votes for the nominees, by placing their ballots in ballot boxes designated during the event. Voting will take place on 27 November between 9 a.m and 5 p.m.
15. The results will be announced during the gala ceremony on the first day of the Congress, in the evening.
16. During the gala, three people will be selected to receive statuettes of equal value gold, silver and bronze and a diploma.

§ 4. Prizes

17. The winners of the Competition will receive statuettes 'Safe Place Community Discovery of the Year in the Safety Leader category' in three categories: gold, silver and bronze, which are of equal value.
18. In addition, the winners will receive certificates of recognition acknowledging their achievements.

§ 5. Personal data protection

19. The personal data administrator is Safety Project sp. z o.o. with its seat in Wrocław, ul. Zaulek Rogoziński 11b/4, 51-116.
20. The administrator of the Participants' personal data is the Organiser in accordance with Article 4(7) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons in relation to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, hereinafter, "the Regulation".
21. The data shall be processed in the context of the execution of the application and the participation in the organised Competition.

23. Participation in the Competition is voluntary and requires the Participants consent to the processing of personal data and acceptance of the Rules and Regulations.
24. Personal data will be processed for the period necessary to secure the proper conduct of the Conference (no longer than until 31.12.2025) or until the withdrawal of consent – in the case of data provided on an optional basis.
25. Participants have the rights to access the content of the data to request rectification, restriction of processing, data portability and to object to its processing.
